- Licensing Support Network (LSN) Certification December 2007
 - Actual: October 19, 2007
- Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement May 2008
 - Actual: June 16, 2008
- License Application (LA) Submittal June 30, 2008
 - Actual: June 3, 2008
- U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Docketing and Hearings
 - Actual: NRC Docketing: September 8, 2008
 - Federal Register Notice of Hearing: TBD





Relationship of NRC Staff Review Process to the Hearing Process

- Staff Safety and Environmental Reviews (10 CFR Parts 63 and 51)
- Parallel But Separate Hearing Process Before Atomic Safety and Licensing Boards (ASLBs)
 (10 CFR Part 2)
 - Subparts C & G General Applicability
 - Subpart I Classified Information
 - Subpart J Yucca Mountain Project (YMP)-Specific (e.g. LSN)
 - Appendix D YMP-Specific Hearing Milestones





Role of the ASLB

- ASLBs Comprised of Three Judges (one legal, two technical)
- ASLBs Control Hearing Process, Including:
 - Schedules/Hearing Location
 - Procedural Rulings (Including Admissibility of Parties and Contentions)
 - Conduct of Pre-hearing Conferences
 - Discovery Rulings
 - Rulings on Motions
 - Conduct of Evidentiary Hearing
 - Findings of Fact/Conclusions of Law
- ASLBs Have Authority to Authorize NRC Staff to Issue License, or to Condition or Deny Issuance of the License





Initial Major Milestones in the Hearing Process

- DOE tenders LA and National Environmental Policy Act documents (June 3, 2008 and June 16, 2008)
- NRC dockets LA (September 5, 2008)
- NRC issues Federal Register Notice of Hearing (TBD)
- Petitions to Intervene filed with the NRC (+ 60 days)
- Commission Forwards Petitions to Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel
- DOE Answers (TBD)
- Petitioners' Reply (TBD)
- Initial Prehearing Conference (shortly after receipt of replies)
- ASLBs Grant/Deny Petitions and Admit/Reject Contentions (+ 30 days)
