Current Budgets





Fiscal Year 2024 Enacted Budget: \$8,482M

- Spent Nuclear Fuel/Special Nuclear Materials: \$563M (6%)
- Tank and Liquid Radioactive Waste: \$3,157M (37%)
- ◆ Transuranic Waste, Solid Radioactive Waste: \$1,073M (13%)
- ◆ Facility Decontamination and Decommissioning: \$1,682M (20%)
- Soil and Water Remediation: \$540M (6%)
- ♦ Site Services: \$1,495M (18%)

Technology Projects Portfolio: \$102.82M

- Spent Nuclear Fuel/Special Nuclear Materials: \$11.40M (11%)
- Tank and Liquid Radioactive Waste: \$54.82M (54%)
